**Budget Account's Primary Purpose, Function and Statutory Authority**

The purpose of this work program is to balance forward unexpended funds and establish the Commission for Women budget for fiscal year 2024.

**Purpose of Work Program**

The purpose of this work program is to balance forward unexpended funds and establish the Commission for Women budget for fiscal year 2024.

**Justification**

This work program will enable the Commission to continue its work such as collect data relevant to women, influence socio-economic factors that affect the status of women, and to recommend relevant legislature per the requirements of NRS 233I.

This work program also requests RGL 3893 - License Plate Charge, 4251 - Gifts and Donations, and 4267 - Community Foundation Funding to be established for fiscal year 2024.

Assembly Bill 499 in the 80th (2019) Session allows for the issuance of special license plates to commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States. A portion of the fees for the special license plates will be collected into RGL 3893 License Plate Charge.

Per NRS 233I.090, the Commission may apply and receive gifts, grants, contributions or other money from the Federal Government, private agencies, affiliated associations and other persons for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this chapter, and to defray expenses incurred by the Commission in the discharge of its duties.

In order to expend the funds, the Commission will have to follow all statues, rules, and procedures that are applicable to state agencies.

Fiscal year 2023 Remaining Balance = \$31,267.54  
Fiscal year 2022 Balance Forward = \$31,268  
Fiscal year 2023 Additional Donations = \$15,000

This work program will also establish authority for Revenue General Ledger 3893 - License Plate Charge, 4251 - Gifts and Donations, and 4267 - Community Foundation Funding for fiscal year 2024.

**Expected Benefits to be Realized**

Per NRS 233I.606 Powers and Duties:

1. The Commission shall study the changing and developing roles of women in society, including the recognition of socio-economic factors that influence the status of women and recommend relevant legislature.
2. The Commission may collect and disseminate information of activities, programs and essential services available to the women in Nevada.

**NRS 233I.010 “Commission” defined.** As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, “Commission” means the Nevada Commission for Women.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1910](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

**NRS 233I.020 Creation; membership; designation of Chair and Vice Chair; terms of officers.**

1. The Nevada Commission for Women, consisting of 10 members appointed by the Governor, is hereby created.
2. The members appointed to the Commission must reflect varied political philosophies regarding issues of concern to women.
3. The Governor shall designate one member of the Commission to serve as Chair and one member of the Commission to serve as Vice Chair.
4. Each Chair, Vice Chair and other officer of the Commission shall serve for a term of 1 year.
5. No more than five members of the Commission may be from the same political party.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1910](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

**NRS 233I.030 Members: Terms of office; reappointment; vacancies.** Except for the initial members, the term of office of each member of the Commission is 3 years and commences on July 1 of the year of appointment. The members shall continue in office until their successors are appointed. Members are eligible for reappointment, except that no member may serve for any part of more than two consecutive terms. Vacancies must be filled by appointment for the unexpired terms by the Governor.

**NRS 233I.040 Members: Reimbursement for certain expenses.** Members of the Commission receive no compensation for their services, but are entitled to be reimbursed for all travel and other expenses actually and necessarily incurred by them in the performance of their duties, within the limits of money available from gifts, grants, contributions and other money received pursuant to [NRS 233I.090](#).

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1910](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

**NRS 233I.050 Meetings; quorum.** The Commission shall meet at the call of the Chair as frequently as required to perform its duties, but no less than quarterly. A majority of the members of the Commission constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business, and a majority of those present at any meeting is sufficient for any official action taken by the Commission.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1911](#); A [1995, 1921](#); [2013, 1617](#))

**NRS 233I.060 Powers and duties.**

1. The Commission shall study the changing and developing roles of women in society, including the recognition of socioeconomic factors that influence the status of women, and recommend proposed legislation.
2. The Commission may collect and disseminate information on activities, programs and essential services available to women in Nevada.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1911](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

**NRS 233I.070 Appointment of committees.** The Chair of the Commission may, with the approval of the Commission, appoint committees from its members to assist in carrying out any of the functions or duties of the Commission.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1911](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

**NRS 233I.080 Department of Administration to provide staff assistance; volunteer workers and consultants.**

1. The Director of the Department of Administration shall provide staff assistance to the Commission as the Governor deems appropriate.

2. The Commission may engage the services of volunteer workers and consultants without salary as is necessary from time to time.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1911](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

**NRS 233I.090 Gifts, grants and contributions.** The Commission may apply for and receive gifts, grants, contributions or other money from the Federal Government, private agencies, affiliated associations and other persons for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this chapter and for defraying expenses incurred by the Commission in the discharge of its duties.

(Added to NRS by [1991, 1911](#); A [1995, 1921](#))

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 482 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

*1. Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) of subsection 8, the Department, in cooperation with the Nevada Commission for Women created by NRS 233I.020, shall design, prepare and issue license plates which commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States, using any colors that the Department deems appropriate.*

*2. Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (a) of subsection 8, the Department shall issue license plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States for a passenger car or light commercial vehicle upon application by a person who is otherwise entitled to license plates pursuant to NRS 482.265 and who otherwise complies with the requirements for registration and licensing pursuant to this chapter. A person may request that personalized prestige license plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 be combined with license*



plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States if that person pays the fees for the personalized prestige license plates in addition to the fees for the license plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States pursuant to subsection 3.

3. The fee for license plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States is \$35, in addition to all other applicable registration and license fees and governmental services taxes. The license plates are renewable upon the payment to the Department of \$10.

4. In addition to all other applicable registration and license fees and governmental services taxes prescribed pursuant to subsection 3, a person who requests a set of license plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States must pay for the issuance of the plates an additional fee of \$25 and for each renewal of the plates an additional fee of \$20, to be deposited in accordance with subsection 5.

5. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.38279, the Department shall deposit the fees collected pursuant to subsection 4 with the State Treasurer for credit to the State General Fund. The State Treasurer shall, on a quarterly basis, distribute the fees deposited pursuant to this subsection to the Nevada Commission for Women for their use in carrying out their duties pursuant to NRS 233I.060, including, without limitation:

(a) Collecting and disseminating information on activities, programs and essential services available to women in Nevada;

(b) Promoting and facilitating collaboration among commissions and organizations for women at the local, state and national levels; and

(c) Recognizing and promoting the contributions that women in this State make at the local, state and national levels.

6. The provisions of NRS 482.36705 do not apply to license plates described in this section.

7. If, during a registration period, the holder of license plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of the vehicle to which the plates are affixed, the holder shall:

(a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that meets the requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for the transfer of the registration and any registration fee or governmental services tax due pursuant to NRS 482.399; or

(b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle, return them to the Department.

8. The Director shall:





*(a) Accept, through the Internet website of the Department, applications for the issuance of the license plates issued pursuant to this section beginning on July 1, 2019. A person who applies for the license plates pursuant to this paragraph must not be charged for any fees imposed by this section or any other registration and license fees and governmental services taxes due for the license plates until the license plates are available for issuance by the Department.*

*(b) Determine, and by public proclamation, announce the last date on which the Department will issue the license plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States. The Department shall publish the announcement on its Internet website. In no case may the date that is determined and announced to be the last day on which the Department will issue the license plates be more than 1 year after the date the license plates are available for issuance by the Department. The Department shall not issue:*

*(1) The license plates that commemorate the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage in the United States after the date announced by the Department pursuant to this paragraph.*

*(2) A duplicate number plate or a replacement number plate for those license plates more than 5 years after the date announced by the Department pursuant to this paragraph.*

**Sec. 2.** NRS 482.2065 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.2065 1. A trailer may be registered for a 3-year period as provided in this section.

2. A person who registers a trailer for a 3-year period must pay upon registration all fees and taxes that would be due during the 3-year period if he or she registered the trailer for 1 year and renewed that registration for 2 consecutive years immediately thereafter, including, without limitation:

(a) Registration fees pursuant to NRS 482.480 and 482.483.

(b) A fee for each license plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.268.

(c) Fees for the initial issuance, reissuance and renewal of a special license plate pursuant to NRS 482.265, if applicable.

(d) Fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a personalized prestige license plate pursuant to NRS 482.367, if applicable.

(e) Additional fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a special license plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 to 482.3823, inclusive, *and section 1 of this act*, which are imposed to generate financial support for a particular cause or charitable organization, if applicable.
