Dennis McHugh, Department of Administration employee and Army veteran, named December's State Employee Veteran of the Month

CARSON CITY, NV – Today, the Nevada Department of Administration announced that longtime state employee and Army veteran Dennis McHugh has been named the state's December Employee Veteran of the Month for his outstanding contributions to the State of Nevada.

McHugh served in the United States Army for eight years, including overseas deployment in Operation Desert Storm.

Following his military service, McHugh went on to spend a 26-year career in public service with the State of Nevada where he worked in information technology, most recently as the Department of Administration's Information Security Officer. In this role, McHugh proved instrumental in securing the systems, infrastructure, and information processed and stored by the state's Enterprise IT Services Division, contributing to a more secure IT environment for the executive branch of Nevada state government. McHugh retired from state service on December 28, 2021.

"Like so many of the military veterans working in state government, Dennis brought a special kind of diligence and work ethic to his state career," said Department of Administration Director Laura Freed. "He demonstrated an absolute commitment to protecting the department's information technology, particularly against the threat of malicious attacks.
